Great Pyramid of Khufu, Egypt

The Great Pyramid of Khufu is the largest of the roughly 60 pyramids found on the west bank of the Nile. Composed of some 2.3 million stone blocks weighing 2.5 tons each, this pyramid today measures 230 meters on each side at the base and 137 meters high. Until the construction of the Eiffel Tower, this was the world's tallest structure.

- *This model was designed for Papercraft and may differ from the original in some respects.
- Parts list(pattern):Four A4 sheets(No.3 to No.6)
- No. of Parts:7
- *Build the model by carefully reading the Assembly Instructions, in the parts sheet page order.



*Hint: Trace along the folds with a ruler and an exhausted pen (no ink) to get a sharper, easier fold. Before starting assembly: Writing the number of each section on its back side before cutting out the sections is highly recommended.

(* This way, you can be sure which section is which even after cutting out the sections.)

Indicates where to insert sections. Do not glue the sections together.
